Join us for this performance – a true celebration of 'now' and 'us'.



When two sets of estranged twins are brought together on the same island, this classic comedy takes hold, with mistaken identity, music and manic costume changes aplenty.



Six strangers, weighed down by individual darkness, come to a coastal land. Seemingly abandoned, there is no one to help but themselves. Stuck between the remains of a broken community and the vast bleakness of the sea, they struggle with isolation, shame and failed support systems.


Bollywood Dance workshop is your chance to learn some groovy Bollywood moves, designed for all abilities.






