

Although initially setting out only to play the Tex-Mex style they'd previously heard by artists Ry Cooder and the Texas Tornados, a lot of other border music has crept into the mix over the 28 years they have played together.



Legends of Irish music and song, The Fureys return for their 17th concert at The Mill. The band are renowned for their hit songs I Will Love You, When You Were Sweet 16, The Green Fields of France, The Old Man, Red Rose Café and From Clare to Here.

The oldest of the brothers, Eddie Furey left home in 1966 and travelled to Scotland at the time of the great folk revival, where he shared accommodation with then unknown folk singers Billy Connolly, Gerry Rafferty and Alex Campbell.

In 1969 with his brother Finbar, he was the special guest for the Clancy Brothers and Tommy Makem throughout the USA and Canada. In 1971 he moved to mainland Europe where he toured for seven years. Dave Stewart from the Eurythmics has credited Eddie with teaching him his first chords on guitar.
