You could use a memory from the past 70 years, a previous Jubilee or a memorable event in your life, to inspire your artwork-the choice is yours. You could create a 2D picture and create a window display or something in 3D, on a larger scale, that you can display in your front garden or in a community space.






Here are some ideas to get the creativity flowing!

The sky is the limit for your artistic creation! Simply create something that you can display in your window, garden or community space for the Platinum Jubilee for everyone to see – starting from Monday 23rd May until the big celebration on the 3rd-6th June.

If you need a starting point, you could cut a piece of paper into one of the shapes below, decorate it, and display it in your window. You could make more than one, join them together with string or wool and turn them to bunting to display in your window. You could design it yourself or make them with friends and family.




create sculpture for your garden using flower pots or recycled materials
